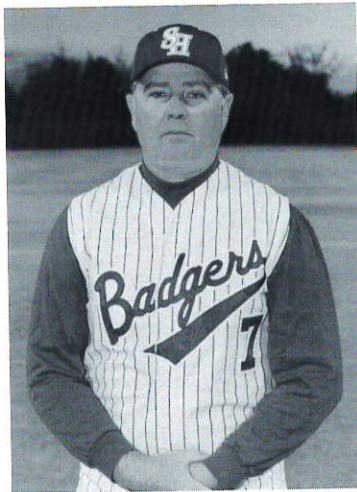

HEAD COACH FRANK SIMS



Sims begins his 17th full season with the Badgers as the school's all-time winningest coach. His record of 508-403-3 at Spring Hill includes 15 20-win seasons, six 30-win seasons, two 40-win seasons and four Gulf Coast Athletic Conference championships. Spring Hill has also appeared in the NAIA Region Tournament four times, and Sims has been honored as GCAC Coach of the Year on four occasions.

Overall, Sims has posted a 544-403-3 mark in 19 seasons as a collegiate head coach. He gained the milestone 500th victory at Spring Hill in the 2001 season against rival University of Mobile.

In the last decade, Spring Hill saw its greatest success on the diamond, posting eight 30-win seasons, including a school-best 40-15 mark in

1992, which culminated in a District-30 crown. The 1992 team also set 18 team, individual and conference records that year. Last season's team tied the school record for victories in a season with a 40-25 mark. The Badgers also won the GCAC Championship and advanced to the NAIA Region 13 Tournament for the first time in four seasons. That team set 22 team and individual school records.

Fifty-four players have been named All-Gulf Coast Athletic Conference during Sims' tenure on "The Hill," including two-time NAIA All-American and current Major League Baseball starting pitcher Blake Stein, and current Kansas City Royals farmhand Trae McGill.

Sims began his coaching career as an assistant at his alma mater, Eastern Illinois University. After one season at EIU, Sims moved on to Sparta High School in Illinois, where he served as head coach for the baseball team, in addition to assistant positions in both football and basketball. Sims posted a 44-18 record in three seasons on the diamond.

After his experience at Sparta, Sims returned to the collegiate ranks in 1980, serving two seasons as an assistant at Morehead State. He later became the head baseball coach at Milton College in 1983, where his squad finished 36-10, narrowly missing a berth into the NAIA World Series. Two seasons as an assistant coach at the University Wisconsin-Whitewater followed before he arrived at Spring Hill.

Sims earned his bachelor's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from Eastern Illinois in 1977, and his master's degree from Morehead State in Kentucky in 1980. He and his wife, Dana, have four children: Drew 18, Sarah, 15, Kelsey, 13, and Brian, 11.

2003 SEASON PREVIEW

The Badgers begin their 113th season at Spring Hill College, with high hopes of returning to the NAIA National Championships, to be held this year in Lewiston, Idaho. With head coach Frank Sims entering his 19th season here at "The Hill," he is expecting the leadership and experience of the upperclassmen to help the newcomers bring the team together and earn a berth in the National Tournament.

Among the top returning players is outfielder Dan Quatrino, a 6'0" senior from Tampa, Florida. Last year he led the team in batting average (.399), at bats (198), runs (47), hits (79), and doubles (17). He will continue to bring a lot of power to the batting order and a good arm in the outfield. Pitcher Dan Padron is another top returning player. He is a 5'10" junior from Miami, Florida. Last year he finished the season with record of 7-4 and an ERA of 4.26. Aaron Barras, another junior pitcher, was 4-3 last year with a 4.76 ERA. Junior pitcher Justin Givhan will also return to the pitcher rotation, and he will be looking to improve on his 6-4 record.

Two other returning starters from last year are sophomores Grant Allenbach and Evan Lee. Grant Allenbach is a 5'10" infielder. Last year he batted .245, with 27 hits, 5 runs, and 9 RBIs. He also had a fielding percentage of .936. Evan Lee is a 6'1" outfielder. Last year he batted .268, had 30 hits, 25 runs, 7 doubles, and 13 RBIs. In the field, he had 63 putouts and a fielding percentage of .971.

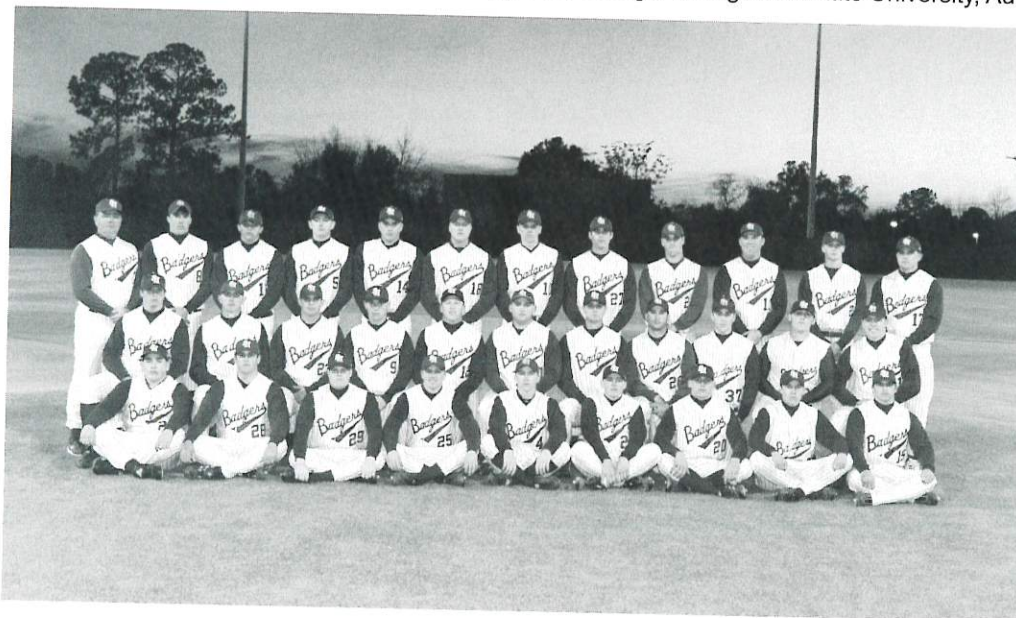
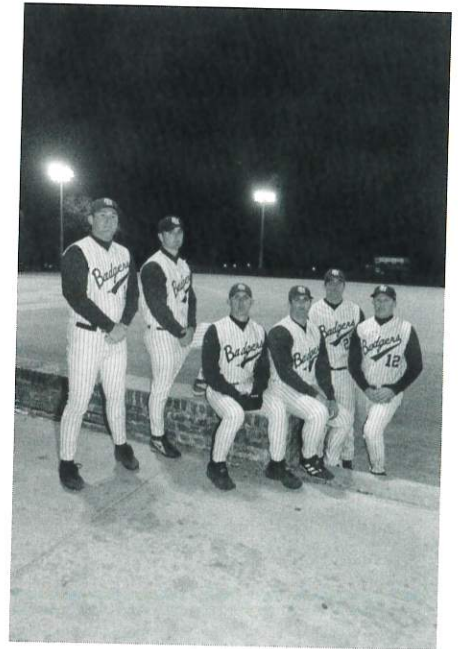
Coach Sims said, "I expect these players to show the leadership we need to get back into the NAIA Region 13 Tournament. All have valuable experience and we are looking for big things from all of them."

Coach Sims has an outstanding recruiting class. Some of the top players that he recruited are junior pitcher Jake Ledkins of Excel, Alabama (transferred from Alabama Southern Community College); freshman outfielder Matt Parker of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; freshman outfielder Tyler Kerns of Mobile, Alabama (graduated from St. Paul's Episcopal High School); senior infielder Rawley Fox of Tampa, Florida; freshman infielder Nathan Schneider of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and sophomore infielder Banks Walker of Spanish Fort, Alabama (transferred from Auburn University). These recruits will be looking up to the seniors and juniors for the guidance to help the team out and to learn the tradition of Spring Hill Baseball.

The team has set two main goals for the season. The first is winning the Gulf Coast Athletic Conference, which includes the schools of the University of Mobile, Belhaven College, William Carey College, Loyola University, and Louisiana State University at Shreveport, and advancing to the NAIA National Tournament.

Spring Hill competes in the NAIA Region 13, and will be facing a number of regional teams this season outside of the conference. They include Faulkner University, North Georgia College and State University, Auburn University at Montgomery, and Thomas University.

"We have a chance to be a pretty good ball club if we can hit in the clutch. The conference schedule is key to a successful season, plus the games versus the region 13 teams. Overall, we have a chance to be a pretty good team if we stay with the basics and play with a lot of heart."

2003 SEASON PREVIEW



The Spring Hill Softball Team begins season number six with their eyes set on the NAIA National Championship Tournament. Led by Head Coach Coby Mackin, the Lady Badgers will be looking to continue the success that has come to the Spring Hill Softball team over the short history of the program. Losing three starters from last years team, including one starting pitcher, the team will call on several talented newcomers to step up and fill-in at the positions that have been vacated.

The team will be facing some tough competition this season, not only against teams in the GCAC, but against teams in the NAIA Region 13 and across the southern United States. The team will be in three tournaments, two at the University of West Florida and the NAIA Leadoff Classic in LaGrange, Georgia. These tournaments will include some of the top softball teams from in the country and give the Lady Badgers a chance to face competitive NAIA and NCAA teams.

Returning from last year's team with much experience and leadership are seniors Amber Erickson (pitcher), Rene'e Hurley (second base), and Allison Sellers (center field). All three will use their experience to contribute to the 2003 team.

On the mound, Amber Erickson, the junk ball pitcher with a career record of 34-18, will serve as a perfect compliment to the power pitching of junior Alicia Perry, sophomore Aracely Rodriguez, and sophomore Valerie Ricketts.

In 2002, Rene'e Hurley was the fourth leading hitter with a .356 in 30 games. She came to the plate 45 times, had 16 hits, and batted in 16 runners. Rene'e also had an impressive fielding percentage last year, with 62 putouts, 31 assists, and 4 errors, which calculates to a .959 fielding percentage. With experience at almost every position, Rene'e will lead the middle infield at second base with freshman McCall McDaniel at shortstop.

Allison Sellers is coming off a stellar 2002 season. This year she is the number one returning hitter in batting average (.378), on base percentage (.423), runs scored (29), hits (51), and stolen bases (12). Allison will look for support offensively from transfers Danielle DeLeon (third base), Jennifer Girrod (catcher/third base), and freshman Lindsay Quick (catcher/third base). The three seniors will look to sophomores Jessica Weltin, Amy Daigle, Keiko Booth, and freshman Dana Kelly for their offensive and defensive versatility to impact this 2003 team.
