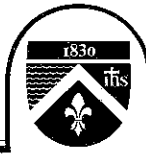

What can the Badgers do for an encore this 1993 Baseball Season? Can they match last years 40-15 record, District 30 champions, Sweet Sixteen finish, a Top 20 ranking, and breaking 18 team, school, and conference records? Tune in this Spring for further details!

Spring Hill College Baseball program had an historic year in 1992! Their 40 wins crushed the old record of 33 set in 1983. They were District 30 champions and were in the Top 20 rankings in 1992. Shortstop Kevin Grimes was second in the Nation in hitting and was named Player of the Year in Gulf Coast Athletic Conference. He was also an Honorable Mention All-American. Joe Stutz, Justin Foltz, Jeff Burg, Chris Roa, and Kevin Grimes were named All-Conference and All-District. As a team the Badgers were second in the Nation in pitching with a 2.61 E.R.A. Team batting was ninth and team fielding was fifteenth in the Nation! What a year!!

Coach Sims is looking to this spring with great anticipation. Although he lost six seniors, the Badgers return fourteen lettermen to this years team. "We should be stronger defensively and I see us as an overall much faster team. Our players know what it takes to be a Top 20 team and a District 30 champion, so they are staying pretty focused."

The 1993 schedule as always is a strong one. The Badgers will have to be razor sharp to keep up their continued success. As always, the Badgers baseball family invites you and your family to come out and support your Badger Baseball Team. We hope to see you this Spring.



Head Coach — Frank Sims

Coach Sims is starting his eighth year as Head Baseball Coach at Spring Hill College. He is from Charleston, Illinois and has been coaching since 1976.

Sims coaching career started at Eastern Illinois University as an assistant. That year they won 36 and lost 9 and were ranked in the top 10 in the nation. After one year at E.I.U. he took over a losing program at Sparta Illinois. He was the football, basketball and baseball coach. In his three years at Sparta Sim's team won 44 and lost only 18 games.

After three years at Sparta he left to pursue his graduate degree at Morehead State in Kentucky. He worked under former New York Yankee pitcher Steve Hamilton. After earning his degree, Sims became the head coach at Milton College in Wisconsin. Little did he know that his first year there would be the schools last year of existence. His team was 36 and 10 and was one game away from the NAIA World Series, the most successful team in the school's history! After Milton closed he was an assistant at the University of Wisconsin Whitewater for two years. Coach Sims took over at Spring Hill late in the 1985 season. His 1992 team went 40-15 and set 18 team, individual and conference records.

Coach Sims feels that school is the most important part of his players life on campus. "The players are here to get their education first and to play ball-second." That's why Coach Sims baseball team has a 100% graduation rate since he has been at Spring Hill.

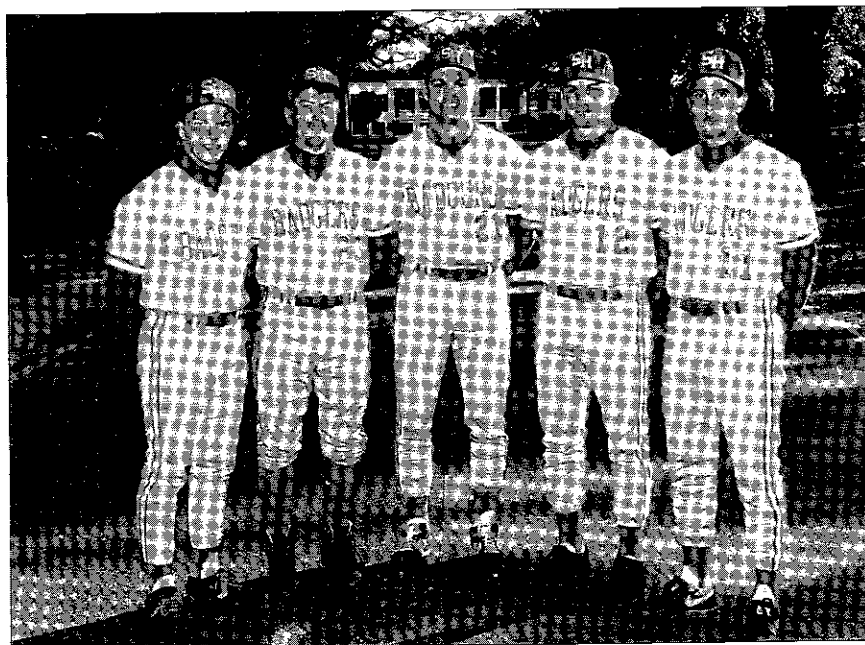
Head Coach

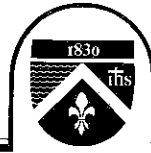

Freshman — Pitcher — Fairfield, NJ

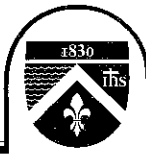
Jim had great high school credentials coming in and pitched well this Fall. "If Jim can get command of his off speed pitches, he could see a lot of innings for us this year."

Junior — Catcher — Shreveport, LA

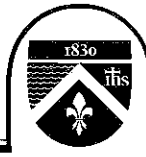

Freshman — INF/OF — Daphne, AL

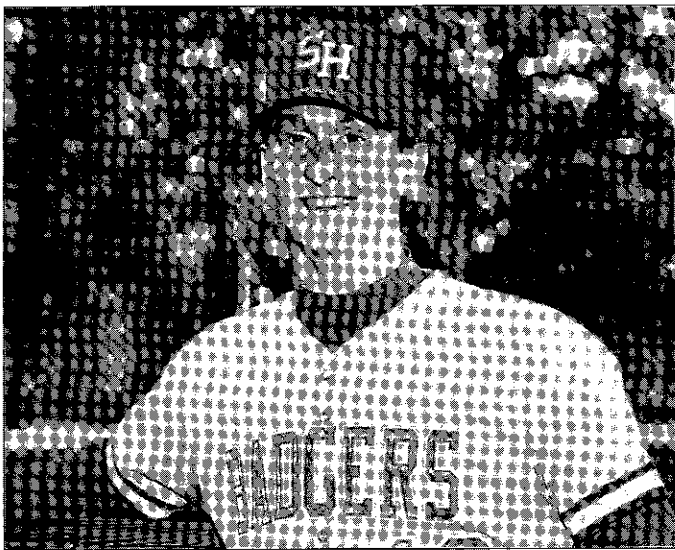

Sophomore — Pitcher — Folsom, LA

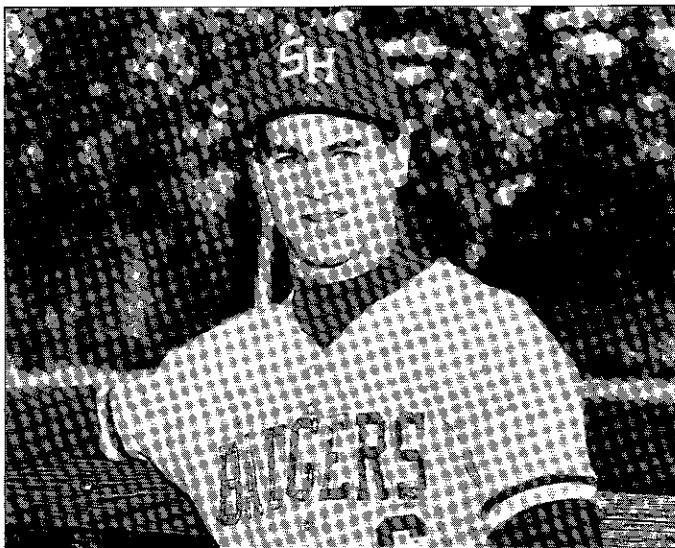

Sophomore — OF — Mobile, AL

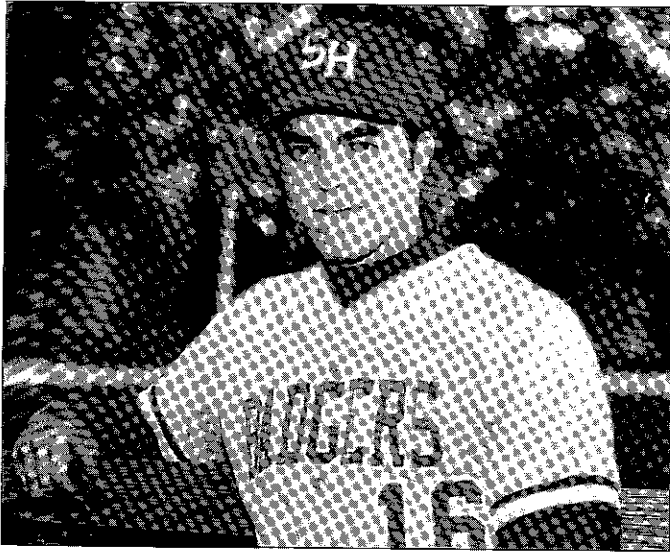

Sophomore — Pitcher — Long Beach, MS

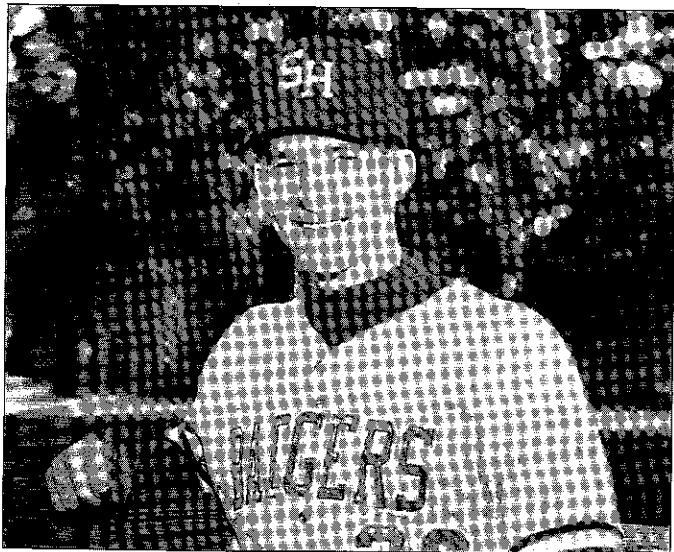

Sophomore — OF — Mobile, AL

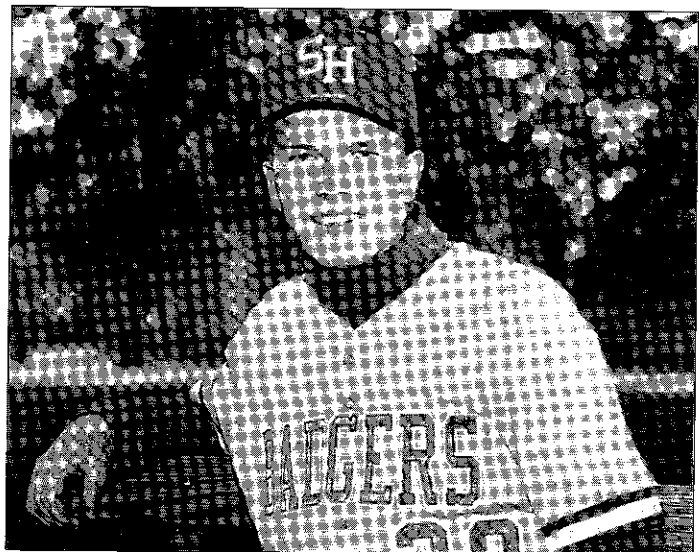

Sophomore — 1st Base — Glendale, AZ

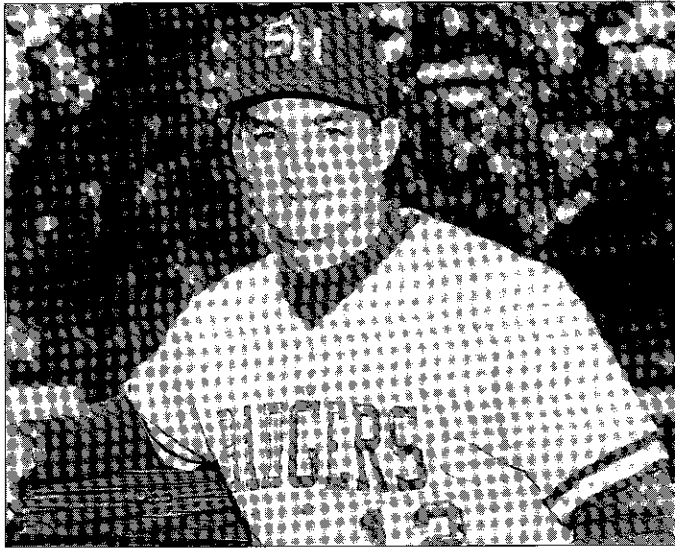
Bill worked very hard over the summer and has improved in leaps and bounds. "Bill is very intense and loves to play the game. We are looking for Bill to contribute this season."

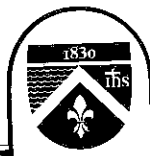


Ruben Rodriguez
