On behalf of the Spring Hill College family, I extend to you a warm welcome as we prepare for another great athletic season.


We are grateful for the attendance and support of our fans. Your continued support is a vital link in our chain of success.

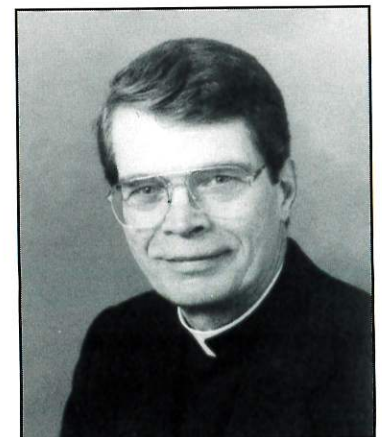

BRING ON THE BIG GUNS!



The Spring Hill College Badgers are optimistic about the upcoming season. During the last four seasons, Spring Hill has posted a 89-38 record while winning one GCAC regular season championship, winning three GCAC Tournament championships and making three NAIA National Tournament appearances. During the 1992-93 season, they advanced to the NAIA National Tournament "Sweet 16".

The Badgers finished the '94-95 season with a record of 21-8, and were ranked in the NAIA top 25 the entire season. After being ranked #15 in the preseason polls, SHC posted a convincing early season 20-point win against then ranked #7 St. Mary's University of San Antonio, Texas. That win, along with a 7-0 record, helped earn the Badgers a #4 ranking during the month of December.

This year's squad will be led by NAIA All-American candidate *Eric Lovett* and GCAC All-Conference candidate *Eddie Timmons*. Lovett, a 6'5" junior point guard, has started every game since his freshman season. In 61 games, he has averaged 11.3 ppg., 4.2 rpg. and 2.8 apg. He is a very versatile athlete who will probably play some at all five positions during the '95-96 season. Timmons, a 6'7" junior power forward who has missed 14 games in two seasons due to injuries, is averaging 8.9 ppg. and 5.1 rpg. He will bring toughness to the Badgers' inside attack.

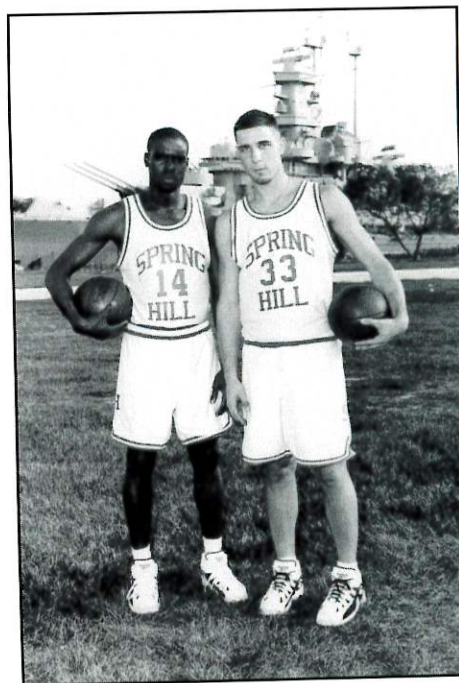
The Badger's strength this year will again be in the backcourt. Senior *Stephen Sterling* and junior *Chad Frazier* will be counted on to carry some of the scoring load. Both possess good jump shots and gained valuable defensive experience a year ago. Also, look for sophomore *Josh Frerman* to step in and provide the Badgers with some valuable depth off the bench. Red-shirt sophomore *Alfonso Cueto* will share some of the low post duties with Timmons. Cueto showed some signs of greatness during GCAC play last season.

The Badgers have added seven players to their roster for the upcoming season. Look for freshman *Eric Campbell* to see significant action at the small forward position. He is a tremendous

athlete who will be an opponent's nightmare around the basket. Freshmen *Ronald Robinson*, *Jason Allen* and sophomore *Lance Daugherty* will provide some strong back up in the post. Rounding out the Badger's" roster will be red-shirt sophomore *Dwight Ladd*, freshman *Wali Harrison* and freshman *Chad Buckhaults*.

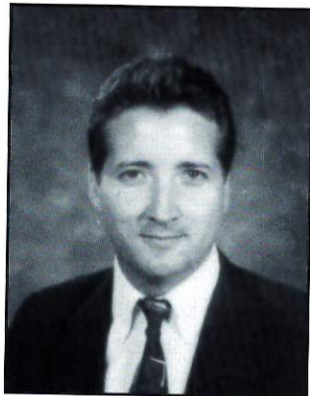
As always the Badgers will play some very good pre-conference opponents that will include Auburn-Montgomery, Faulkner University and defending NAIA National Champion Birmingham Southern College, to help them prepare for a tough GCAC schedule. Spring Hill will start the new year in Charlotte, North Carolina, at the Marriott Classic, where the Badgers will be competing against NCAA Division II opponents.

Spring Hill will have the blend of experience and youth. For them to make it to their fourth National Tournament, they must play well as a team. If the Badgers blend and progress as the season goes on, look for them to make a run at their fourth title and yet another berth in the NAIA National Tournament.

1995-96 MEN'S BASKETBALL COACHES



Joe Niland
Men's Basketball Coach

Joe Niland is entering his third season as the Badger head coach. During the past two seasons he has posted a 43-18 record, led the Badgers to a GCAC tournament championship, a NAIA National Tournament

appearance and a #4 NAIA national ranking during December of the 1994-95 season.

Coach Niland is familiar with programs rich in tradition. From 1990-1993, he assisted Gordon Gibbons at Florida Southern College in Lakeland, Florida. He helped lead the Moccasins to a 73-20 record, two Sunshine State Conference Championships and two berths in the NCAA Division II National Tournament. In 1990-91, FSC finished #4 in the NCAA Division II final poll. From 1988-90, Coach Niland was an assistant to Richard Schmidt at the University of Tampa. There he helped lead the Spartans to two SSC titles and two NCAA Division II National Tournaments. The Spartans were ranked #1 in the NCAA Division II final poll.

The Buffalo, New York, native is no stranger to Jesuit higher education. Niland's father starred at Canisius College, a Jesuit school in Buffalo, from 1938-42 and returned to coach the Golden Griffins from 1947-54. The senior Niland was also the player personnel director and chief scout of the Buffalo Braves (NBA) from 1969-74. Niland's uncle, Thomas J. Niland, was the Athletic Director at LeMoyne College, a Jesuit school in Syracuse, New York, from 1947-92. The Niland family association with Jesuit institutions has continued with Niland's younger brother, Dave, working as an assistant at Canisius College since 1992.

Joe is married to the former Ellen Bonin and they have three children, A.J., Katelin and Jake.

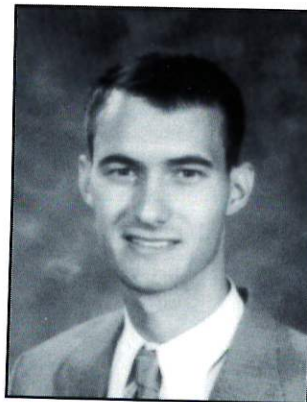


Frank Sims

Frank Sims begins his eleventh year at Spring Hill College as head baseball coach and his third year as Athletic Director. Before joining Spring Hill in 1985, Sims was an assistant coach at Eastern Illinois University

in 1976, head baseball coach for Sparta High School from 1977-80, head baseball coach at Milton College in 1982, and assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin Whitewater from 1983-85.

Coach Sims earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Iowa and his master's degree from Morehead State University in Kentucky. Coach Sims and his wife, Dana, have four children, Drew, Sarah, Kelsey and Brian.



Ben Daggett
Assistant Men's Basketball Coach

Ben Daggett is entering his first year as an assistant at Spring Hill. Daggett, a native of Marianna, Arkansas, received his bachelor's degree in Kinesiology from the University of Arkansas.

While at Arkansas, he was a student assistant for Coach Nolan Richardson's Arkansas Razorbacks from 1991-95. During that time, the Razorbacks won three SEC championships, one SEC tournament championship, made two Final Four appearances and won one NCAA National Championship.

Daggett, who credits Coach Richardson and his staff for his development and knowledge of the game, will assist with recruiting, scouting and administrative duties in addition to his on-the-floor coaching duties.

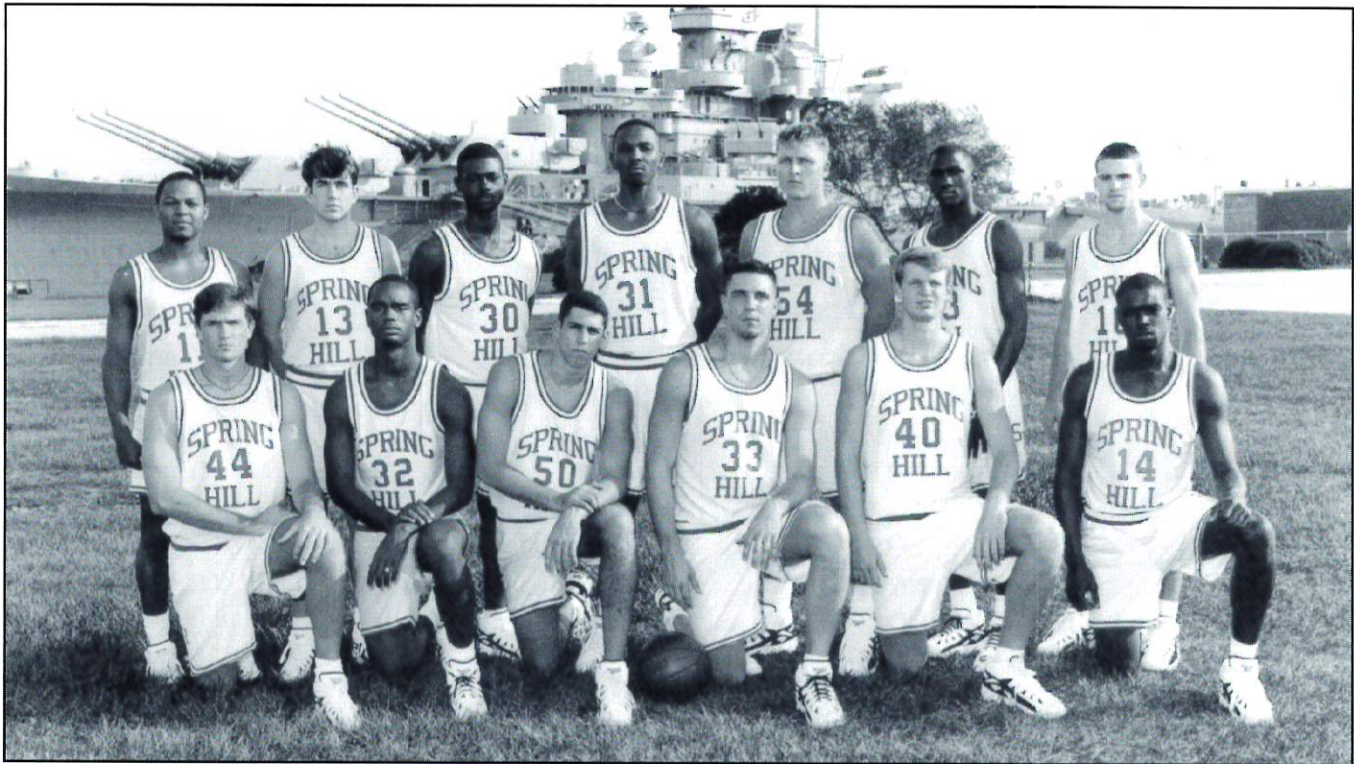

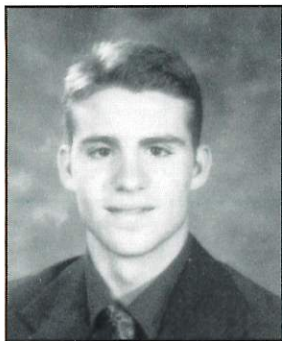

Chad hails from the Washington D.C. area and has a good basketball background. He will be red-shirted this season and will work on becoming acclimated to the game on

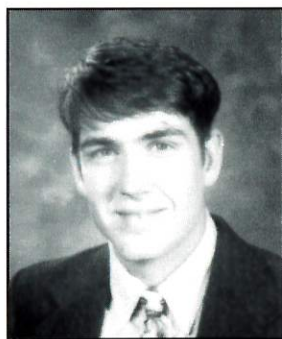

Stephen's three full years of experience will be a big asset this season. He has good range on his jump shot and will be looked upon to score

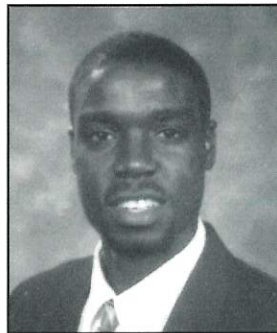

Also known as "Hunter", Chad is a very good long range shooter. He shot better than 50% from the 3-point arc last season and will be the Badgers' main outside threat this

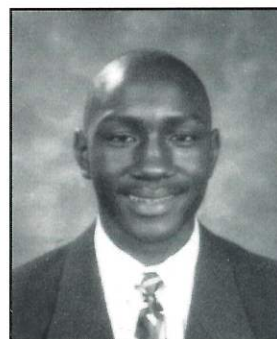

Eric "You Gotta" Lovett has been the Badgers' starting point guard for the past two seasons. His steady all around play has not only kept the Badgers nationally ranked in the

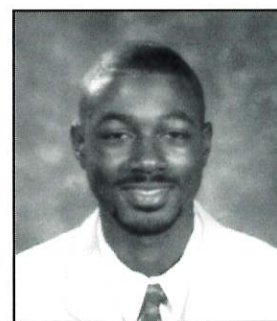

Wali has the potential to be a good player in the GCAC. He is very athletic and has the ability to be a good defensive player. He will add valuable depth to the Badgers' back-

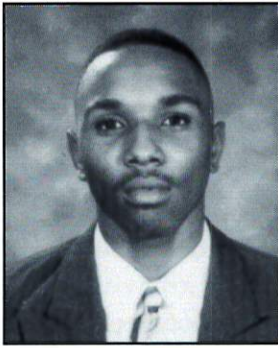

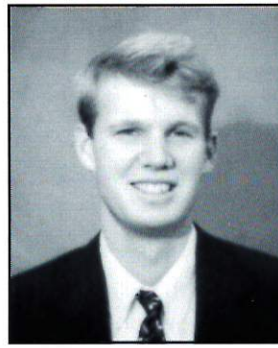


#31 Eric Campbell

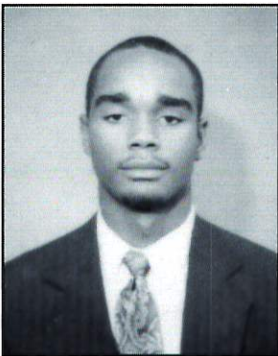


#40 Jason Allen

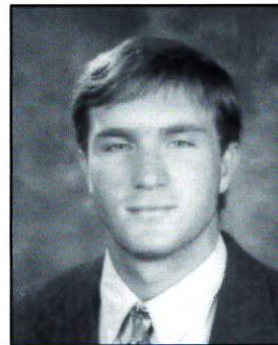


#32 Ronald Robinson

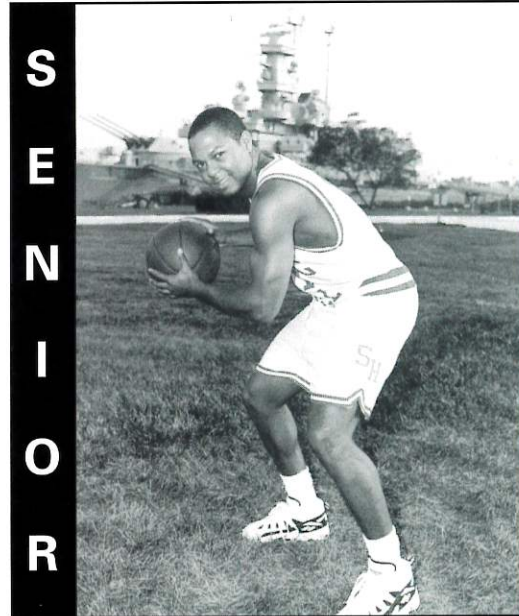


#55 Lance Daugherty

After hovering around 500 and finishing fourth in the GCAC for the past two seasons, the Lady Badgers are ready to make a move into the league's upper echelon. All contributing letter winners from the team that finished 18-15 a year ago are back. With the addition of a few players, this year's edition of the Lady Badgers are "On a Mission".

The strength of the Lady Badgers will be its frontcourt. Junior *Alison Kahn* and sophomore *Donmeke Martin* earned all-conference honors last season. Kahn led the GCAC in field goal percentage (63.1 %) and averaged 14.1 ppg., while Martin led the team in scoring (16.1 ppg.) and rebounding (11 rpg.). The team's enforcer will be senior *Jamie Poiroux*. She averaged 8.5 ppg. and played a vital role during conference play last season. Rounding out the frontcourt will be red-shirt sophomore *Ellie Ramey* and freshman *Jennifer Nalu*. They will add stability and depth at the post positions.

If there is a concern for Coach Walker, it will be with the teams perimeter play. Due to injuries, the backcourt was without experienced depth during the 1994-95 season. The majority of the load was carried by three players. Senior *Elaine Derrick* was the team's third leading scorer (12.7 ppg.) and best free-throw shooter (80.1 %). Senior *Meg Ekins* led the team in 3-point field goal accuracy (37.2 %), and junior *Deon Kerne* handed out 139 assists. Hoping to add depth to the backcourt after gaining valuable experience last season will be junior *Megan Johnson* and sophomore *Alice Turni*. Johnson has the potential to be the Lady Badgers' main threat from the 3-point arc, and Turni could be one of the better small forwards in the conference. Sophomore transfer *Elvia D'Orcy* is a tremendous athlete who will provide speed and quickness on the perimeter. Rounding out the backcourt will be senior *Lesla Paille*, who will join the team after Cross Country season, and red-shirt sopho-

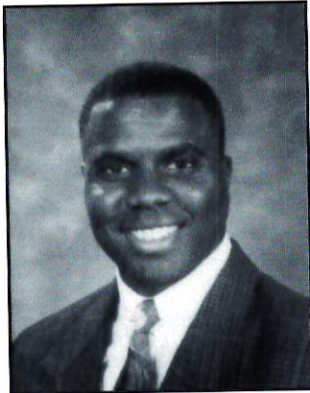
more *Alison Mougey*. They will add stability and depth at the guard positions.

The Lady Badgers will play in the always tough and well balanced GCAC. This will include two games with new conference member Loyola University. James Walker

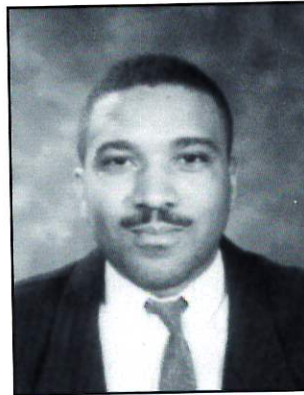
Women's Basketball Coach

Terry Fowler

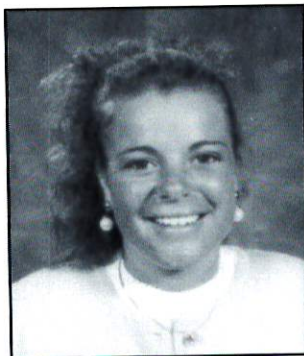
Assistant Women's Basketball Coach
